SEG Level 3 Youth Work in Practice Bootcamp

#### WHAT

### IS YMCA HUMBER YOUTH WORKER TRAINING?

The SEG Level 3 in Youth Work Practice is a JNC recognised qualification. It supports the National Occupational Standards for Youth Work and the skills and knowledge needed to become a competent Youth Support Worker.

The course is being delivered by YMCA Humber in conjunction with National Employer Training, part TEC Partnership.

Our trainer has more than 14 years youth work practitioner experience.



# HOW MUCH INVESTMENT IS REQUIRED?

The course is being delivered as a Skills Bootcamp meaning instead of taking 18 months it will be delivered over 16 weeks.

You must commit to 1-day-per-week of face-to-face training over 16 weeks.

Courses will start in October and March and contact days are Mondays or Tuesdays.

You will need to be working with young people, paid or voluntarily, and the course requires significant commitment from you.

The cost is £256.80\* per learner (usually £2568 per learner).


Organisations with more than 250 employees will be charged £770.40 per learner.

- Intervention strategies in youth work settings
- The principles, knowledge and skills needed for work-based practice
- Working with behaviour that challenges
- Reflective practice and work-based practice

You will be a JNC qualified Youth Support Worker.

Additional units can be completed to achieve the Level 3 diploma.

You can also begin the degree or degree apprenticeship pathway.
